The oldest-known site of human habitation in North America is located just south of Pittsburgh at Meadowcroft Rockshelter.

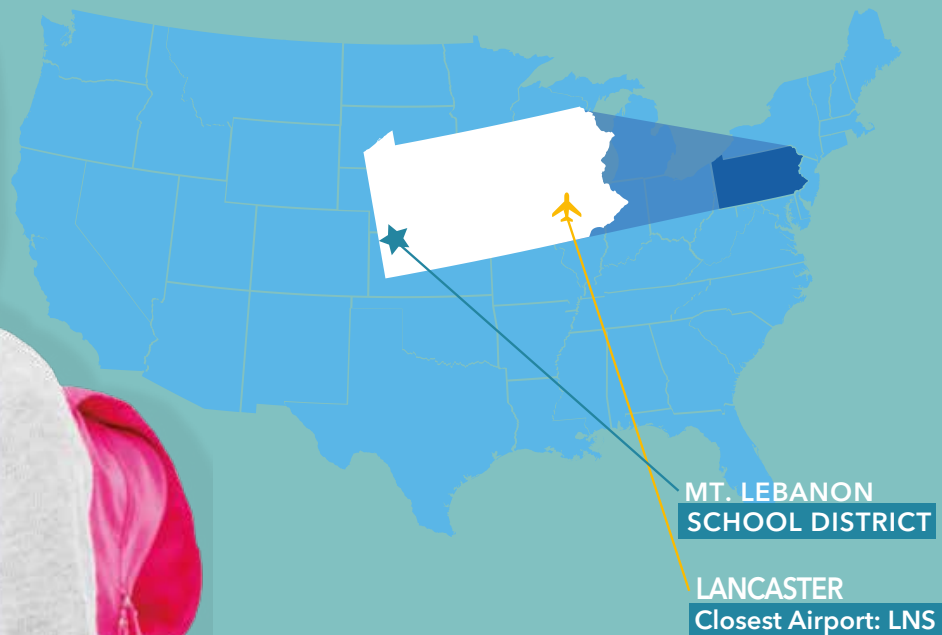
THE STEEL CITY
