In 1621, pilgrims and Native American alike gathered in Plymouth for what is widely regarded as the first celebration of Thanksgiving.

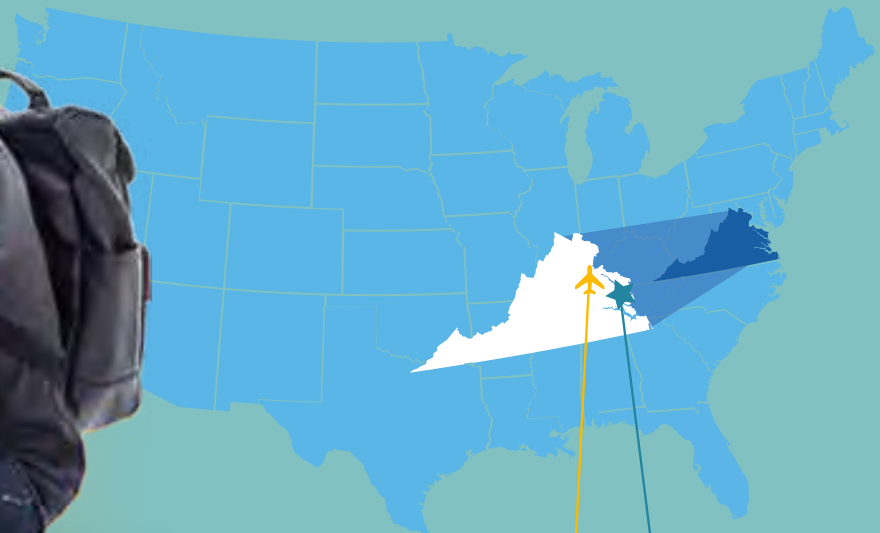
WILDLIFE PRESERVATION

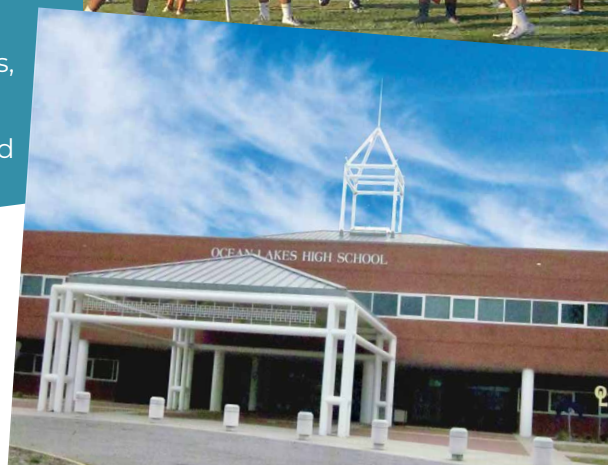
